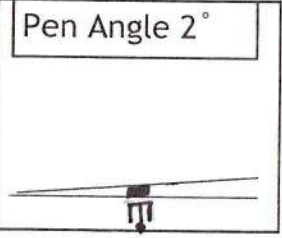
Pen Angle 45°

Pen Angle—this is the angle at which you hold your pen to the writing line. You will see that at a steep angle the line you draw will be slim & at a flatter angle this line will become thicker. Each script you learn has its own pen angle & it is this plus the height of the letters that will give you the distinctive thick and thin strokes that make Calligraphy. Try holding your pen at the angle shown & try drawing some vertical lines. Don't worry about being too accurate just yet, this is just a practice sheet
